

## Elder Abuse Case Management Program

Elder Abuse Case Management Program services are free and provided by Unison at Veiner Centre to those aged 50 and older who are experiencing or are at risk of experiencing elder abuse.

Elder Abuse is any action or inaction by a person in a position of trust that causes harm or distress to an older adult within the scope of emotional, financial, medication, physical, neglect or sexual abuse.

The two most frequently identified and reported types of elder abuse in Canada are financial and emotional.

Our Team:

- accepts referrals from anyone interested in the well-being of older adults;
- works closely with older adults, families, care partners and service providers;
- offers assessment and support while navigating complex systems for the best possible outcomes;
- increases knowledge, skills and competence to help end elder abuse; and,
- provides C.A.R.E. ~ Case Management, Advocacy, Referral and Education.

C.A.R.E. Planning is based on the Community Wellness Model. Advocacy, Crime Prevention, Family Matters, Housing or Lodging, Income Support, Mental Health, Nutrition, Physical Well-being, Recreation or Socialization and Transportation will be considered in elder abuse response.
