Cantara Outreach is a confidential and voluntary support service in place for individuals and families. The outreach team provides a number of services to youth, adults and families, with customized supports being created based on individual needs. Some of which include, but are not limited to:

Court information provision
Family court support
Healthy relationship education & support
Domestic violence education & support
Advocacy
Accompaniment to appointments

Lifeskills education
Assistance with basic needs
Referrals to community services as needed
Goal development & achievement
Transition planning
Crisis support & intervention

Upon your consent, this work is done with community partners such as: RCMP, Children Services, Victim Services, Probations, Mental Health & Addictions, Crown Prosecutors office & local schools.

Cantara outreach services have specialized programs to meet the needs of individuals affected by difficulties in relationships.



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DVIT (Domestic Violence Intervention Team)

DVIT is a non-judgmental, self-driven program that works with men, women and families who are experiencing unhealthy relationships, regardless of criminal charges. DVIT provides quick access to information about your rights and responsibilities, support and advocacy in achieving positive outcomes. DVIT can accommodate varied work schedules, appointment times and meeting locations based on needs.

Safe Youth Program

The safe youth program provides support, education and complex case management to decrease risk factors and increase protective factors for at-risk youth.

Safe Youth provides these services to youth and children (aged 10-22) who have been exposed to domestic violence, trauma, and/or are engaging in risky behaviour. The team works closely with all community organizations to quickly and effectively identify the youths' needs, create a service plan, connect the youth in the community to the support(s) they need, and provide support and follow up.
